Application Fee

\$400 (non-refundable) due with application

Tuition Fees

Kindergarten–Grade 2

\$17,750 per year

Grade 3–12

\$18,250 per year

Includes BC MSP medical coverage, ELL support and International Coordinator support services.

Activity Fees

\$500 for Grade 8–12 only

Does not include overnight trips.

Netbook Computer Fee (optional)

\$600 for Grade 7–12 only

Homestay Fees (September–June)

\$11,000

Includes school bus transportation if required.

Extended Health Coverage

\$500

Dental, travel, prescription drugs etc.

Settlement Services

\$1,000

- Provide Custodian Letter
- Screening and selection of Homestay family
- Communication with parents before and upon arrival
- Purchase medical insurance
- Assistance in purchase of cellphone & phone card
- Assist in finding medical clinics and community services
- Initial homestay visit by the homestay coordinator followed by quarterly reviews
- Communication with parents in native language re: student's quarterly progress
- Continuous review of student's adjustment and homestay living condition
- Special Canadian birthday celebration for the student
- Special invitation letters for the parents visit to Canada

Payment options include cheque, bank draft or wire transfer.

Refund Policy

In the event that a student authorization cannot be obtained, or the student decides not to attend or withdraws from the school, the following refund policy will apply:

Refund of fees, excluding application fee, will be given only if the student visa is not approved. An original copy of rejection letter from the embassy is required. If the student withdraws within 30 days of the start of class, 50% of the tuition fee only is refundable. No refunds if the student withdraws 30 days or more from the start of class.

If the student is applying for immigration status, the school must receive legal documentation by June 30, 2019 in order to qualify for the regular tuition rates. If a student becomes a landed immigrant after June 30, 2019, the full international student tuition rate applies, however, a refund will be issued in the amount of the government grant that the school will receive for that student.
