Surrey Christian School is seeking a Christ-centred, visionary, and learning-focused leader to serve as **Elementary Campus Principal, beginning August 2026**, who is responsible for the spiritual, instructional, relational, and operational leadership of our elementary campus and offers the opportunity to lead within a vibrant, diverse community of educators who serve with passion, competence, and humility.

This role involves leading staff, supporting student learning and wellbeing, fostering a healthy Christian community, and overseeing campus operations. The Elementary Campus Principal works in close collaboration with the campus leadership team and alongside cross-disciplinary whole-school teams that include instructional leaders, inclusive learning services, student support personnel, and operational leaders. Within this collaborative leadership model, the Elementary Campus Principal provides direction and coordination, actively champions the initiatives and projects led by others, and ensures coherence across disciplines while fostering shared ownership of both campus-level and whole-school priorities.
