The Out-of-School Care Assistant plays an integral role in supporting the out-of-school care program. Working under the guidance of the Out of School Care Coordinator, the assistant contributes to creating a nurturing and engaging environment that reflects the school's mission and vision. The assistant assists in program planning, implementation, and administrative tasks to ensure the well-being and development of children outside of school hours. Committed to providing quality care and fostering holistic growth, the assistant collaborates with staff, parents, and community members to create a loving and supportive atmosphere where children feel valued and empowered.

The position is a split shift (before and after school) from September to June, and 8 hours a day for six consecutive weeks during the summer to run our Summer Care Program. We are also open to accepting applications from those also interested in a part-time role for September to June only.

The ideal candidate is passionate about working with young children and dedicated to creating a loving, warm environment. They have the appropriate certification (Assistant or Early Childhood Certification, Responsible Adult, or EA certificate), are at least 19 years old, have up-to-date immunization status, have a valid First Aid certificate, and is a committed Christian and in alignment with our mission, vision, and values.

We offer comprehensive benefits, including extended health benefits, insurance, and professional development opportunities. The wage rate is based on experience and qualifications, with a range of \$24 to \$29 per hour, plus holiday pay and wage enhancements (if applicable). The posted wage is for the 2025/26 school year and is under review; it will be updated for the 2026–27 school year.
