We are accepting applications for a **part-time (20%-40%) Library Tech** position at our Elementary Campus, starting in **August 2026**. Join our vibrant and diverse staff who use their unique gifts to serve with passion, competence, and humility.

The Library Technician works collaboratively to support the day-to-day operations of the Library Learning Commons (LLC) at Surrey Christian School. The successful candidate will help create a welcoming, engaging, and organized space that fosters a love of reading and supports the learning needs of elementary students. This role is ideal for someone who enjoys working with young children, is enthusiastic about children's literature, and values building positive relationships within a school community.

Key responsibilities include assisting with the selection, ordering, cataloging, and processing of books and resources; managing the circulation, inventory, and maintenance of the collection; and supporting the general operations of the LLC. The Library Technician will also help guide students in borrowing materials, using library resources responsibly, and developing foundational research and literacy skills. Supporting classes during scheduled library times and assisting with basic classroom technology may also be part of this role.

Successful candidates:

- Have completed a two-year post-secondary library technician program (Library Technician Diploma) or are working toward a diploma or 2+ years of experience in a similar role.
- are committed to a Christian community, and align with our mission, vision, and values.
- demonstrate strong interpersonal skills and a passion for children's literature and working with young learners.
- have knowledge of library best practices and an understanding of how to support early literacy development; familiarity with educational technology is an asset.
- are organized, adaptable, and attentive to detail.
- proficient computer and software skills, including Insignia and Microsoft Office.

The salary range for the 2025–26 school year is \$27-\$30 per hour, based on experience and qualifications.
